EXHIBITION INFORMATION

Entering the Show:

- Each artist may submit up to 5 original pride-themed pieces (not giclée prints) created within 2 years of the show date.
- Every entry must have your name, email, phone number, title, price and medium on the back.
- All work must be for sale, priced to sell, and remain on display at Tsuga for the duration of the show.
- When delivering your accepted entries to Tsuga, include your submission form (on page 3, listing your titles, prices, media and your contact information), and a single page with your artist's statement and bio.

Accepted Media Include: painting, drawing, collage, scratchboard, prints, mixed media, photography, sculpture, etc. Al-generated

artwork will not be accepted. Giclée prints will not be part of the show, but may be included for sale with your accepted artwork.

Liability: Tsuga Fine Art & Framing takes all reasonable precautions to prevent loss or damage to art, but entrants must assume liability in the event of loss.

Tsuga Fine Art Will:

- Create an electronic announcement and email it to our list of over 2,700 clients
- Promote the exhibition in our e-newsletter, in-house print materials, on a variety of social media and Facebook groups, and local arts- and events-calendar web sites and news media.
- Handle sales and artist payments (Tsuga retains a 40% commission on all art sold).

EXHIBITION DATES AND DEADLINES

Sunday, May 5: Entries Due.

Email high-quality JPG images of your submissions and a scan or photo of your submission form, including your name, address and phone number, to **Tami@tsugafineart.com**.

Tuesday, May 14: Artists will be notified of selection via email.

Friday, May 31, 10am-5pm & Saturday, June 1, 10am-4pm: Artwork delivery.

If your work is selected for inclusion in the exhibition, please deliver the following to Tsuga:

- All accepted artworks, with their titles, medium and price, as well as your name, phone number and email on the back.
- Your submission form and a single page with both your artist's statement & bio.
- If you mail or ship your art, and wish to have it shipped back, please include a check or money order made out to Tsuga Fine Art for return shipping costs, including any necessary insurance.

Tuesday, June 4: Exhibit opens.

Sunday, June 30: Exhibit closes.

Tuesday, July 2 through Sunday, July 7: Artwork pickup.

ENTRY INFORMATION

TWO-DIMENSIONAL ENTRIES

Size Requirements, Including Framing: 80 square inches up to 800 square inches. Works over 100 square inches must be wired to hang; works 80–100 square inches may either be wired or have a saw-tooth hanger.

Works on Canvas: Gallery-wrap canvas must be at least 1" deep, and have finished (painted) edges. Canvas less than 1" deep must be framed. All works must be wired for hanging and paint must be dry — wet paint or damaged frames will not be accepted.

Matted and Framed Work: Matted art must have a glass or plexiglass covering. All 2D work must be ready to hang. No exposed glass edges, clip frames, easel backs, damaged mats or overcuts. Photography: may be black & white, monochrome or colored and can be printed on any medium. The image must be made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or captured digitally. All elements must be original and may not incorporate elements produced by anyone else. Please identify the source (film or digital), and any software programs used to make significant alterations to the image.

THREE-DIMENSIONAL ENTRIES

Sculpture: May be created in any medium: metal, ceramic, glass, wood, paper, mixed materials, etc. If entries exceed 75 lbs., the artist must provide proper pedestals. Small items should be brought in a case for their protection.
